Children will become geologists and mountain rangers during this topic!

They will learn about the characteristics and features of rivers and mountain ranges around the world, including a detailed exploration of the ecosystems and processes that shape them and the land around them.

By reading extracts from this book, we'll learn how to write an intriguing suspense story that will grip the reader. Children will revisit historical learning about significant landmarks, while learning to read maps, locate rivers and understand the characteristics of mountains/ivers and how these wonders of the world are formed and change overtime. They will build their knowledge on landscape art by visiting their local beach and capturing the exquisite landscape experience.
